Parenting across Scotland (PAS) has appointed a new chief executive officer, Amy Woodhouse, to focus efforts on what matters most for Scotland's children and families.

This is a particularly difficult time for many families in Scotland. With almost one in four children in Scotland living in poverty, and many parents struggling to make ends meet, PAS, alongside its partners, has much to do. "The work of PAS is vital. We need strong advocates calling for good decisions in the Scottish Government to improve children's and families' lives. This will only happen if we work collaboratively across the sector. PAS is in an excellent position to build on the knowledge and wisdom of its members to push for change."

Neil Mathers, chair of PAS, said: "I am delighted to welcome Amy to PAS. She brings a wealth of third sector leadership experience and a passion for our work.

"Amy's career has focused on how she can use evidence to create change at policy and practice levels. She is firmly committed to listening to and working with individuals and communities whose voices and experiences are seldom heard.

"Our work and that of our member organisations has never been more relevant. I am thrilled that in Amy we have such an inspirational leader to bring our strategy to life."
